→ What does it mean to volunteer as a group?

- 3. Estimated # of volunteers that you are pledging

→ Registration

- 1. **Share Your Preferred Role** this is just a suggestion for where you'd be most comfortable, you can check multiple boxes!
- 2. Choose Your Shift *establish these selections with your team members!
 - a. Choose your location
 - b. Choose your date
 - c. Choose General Festival Volunteer or Donations Team
- 3. **Indicate your Group Name in the field provided**. This is our signal to match you with your crew.
